AED (Automated External Defibrillator)




Vauxhall School now has an AED outside the main office available 24/7 to our community. A huge thank you to the Delaney family who have fundraised enough money to provide 6 AED's in our community.

An AED is a lightweight, portable device that analyses the heart's rhythm and, if necessary, delivers an electric shock, known as defibrillation, to help restore the heart's natural rhythm. Modern AEDs are designed to be used by someone with little or no training.
